The Camping Committee has set the dates for September 18, 19, and 20, 2026 at The Fort in Fort Recovery, Ohio. This year's theme is **Historic Trails**. The Fort Recovery Historical Society and Fort Recovery Area Arts Council are proud to showcase the newly acquired Opera House. Scouts and Cubs will be participating in a variety of events. The Scouts will be able to earn their American Heritage Merit Badge as well as the Historic Trail patch.

Cub Scouts will be participating in the same general activities as the older Scouts, only in a scaled down version. If Cub Packs want to attend, feel free to come only for the day on Sept. 19, or camp overnight. Packs are encourage to eat with their Scout Troop. However, if Cubs are attending without a Troop, lunch, supper and breakfast will be provided at a cost of \$10.00. (cost for both Adults Leaders and Cubs)

The cost for the Camporee will be \$20.00 per person, which includes admission to the Fort Museum, Opera House, and a Camporee patch. Camporee fees need to be sent to the Findlay Scout Office.
